Students are eligible to receive a \$300 student grant for summer and/or fall 2021. Students not eligible include concurrent high school students, postsecondary enrollment option students (PSEO), or those whose tuition is covered by a tuition waiver.

You may have the grant applied directly to your tuition, or receive it directly. To accept this grant, please complete this [short form](#) by **Friday, June 25 for summer term and/or Friday, September 10 for fall semester**. Once you have accepted your grant, you will see the award applied to your student account within one week and disbursements will be made the third week of the term. Failure to complete the acceptance form by Friday, June 25 for summer term and Friday, September 10 for fall semester will result in eligible students receiving the disbursement directly after the third week of the term.

Funds for the emergency grant are provided through the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) authorized by the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA) and are to be used for expenses under a student's cost of attendance, such as food, housing, transportation, child care, health care, classroom technology, course materials, academic support, and college tuition and fees.
